FINAL EXAMINATION

The date sheet of the final examination is already displayed on the school notice board and the same is printed over leaf. Please help your ward to prepare for the examination according to the schedule. Though some of the exams start from 16th February, 2017 **all the other exams will commence as per schedule below:**

Classes Prep to VIII & XI w.e.f 23rd February, 2017 & Classes IX & X w.e.f 14th March, 2017

Kindly note that buses will leave the school campus for all classes at 12:00 noon on all exam days starting from 23rd February, 2017.

CBSE EXAMINATION :

Like the previous years, this year too, our school is chosen as the Examination centre for the forthcoming Board Examination starting from 9th March, 2017. **Around 600 students** from various schools are expected to write their exams at our centre.

ANSWER SHEETS & REPORT CARD DAY

The parents who wish to see the answer sheets of Final Examination of their ward will be getting an opportunity to see the same on Saturday 18th March, 2017 at 8.00 to 11.30am. Report Card will be given to the parents on Thursday 23rd March, 2017 for classes Prep to VIII & XI. You are requested to come with your ward for the report card without fail. Teachers will be giving out the Report Card from **8:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. Class XI Subject Stream List for the academic session 2016-17 will be displayed on the Notice Board on Saturday 8th April, 2017.**

NEW ACADEMIC SESSION:

The new academic session for classes Prep to IX & XII will commence from Monday, 27th March, 2017. For the students of classes X & XI the new academic session will commence from Monday 10th April, 2017 and 17th April, 2017 respectively. Attendance on the first day is compulsory for all. Prior permission is required if your ward is not able to be present.

SUMMER HOLIDAY

Summer holidays for classes Prep to IX and XI begins from Wednesday 17th May, 2017 and school re-opens on Saturday, 1st July, 2017. **There will be extra classes for the students of classes X & XII from 17th to 27th May, 2017 from 8:00 to 12:00 Noon. It is mandatory for all the students to attend the same so that the syllabus for CBSE board Exam could be completed on time.**

SUMMER UNIFORM

Kindly note from the academic session 2017-18 new uniform for class Prep has been introduced. From the next academic session the uniform for the Junior school will be changed. This year the summer uniform will come into effect from Monday, 27th March, 2017.
